Dear Parents,

Where has the year gone? By now you should have received your child's end of year report. We hope you are pleased with the information you have received and feel that it represents your child's achievements this year. All the teachers have been working hard to capture your child's achievements in what we hope will be a memento of this year.

You should have also received a 'Summary of Achievements' booklet. This document tries to capture our work this year so that you are kept well informed of our progress to improve the school.

We welcome feedback on any aspect of the year or the report and would encourage you to complete and return the feedback form which is attached to the report. These can be anonymously completed but this does make it hard to act on feedback provided.

DINNER MONEY REMINDER:

You will have received a letter in April notifying you of the price increase of school dinners as a result of increased costs for the school meals providers. The price of a school meal will be £2.50 each day from September 2018.

May I take this opportunity to remind all those parents in Year 2 that your Universal Free School Meal entitlement stops when your son/daughter moves into Year 3 and unless you are eligible for free school meals any meals taken require payment.

Did you know that school receives extra funding for children who are eligible for free schools meals? Even if you do not wish your child to have the free school meal and have packed lunch instead the school still benefits if you apply and are eligible. This extra funding is used to provide valuable intervention, resources, extra TA support in classrooms and training to support lots of children across the school so please apply if you think you are eligible so that we get as much extra funding as possible.
